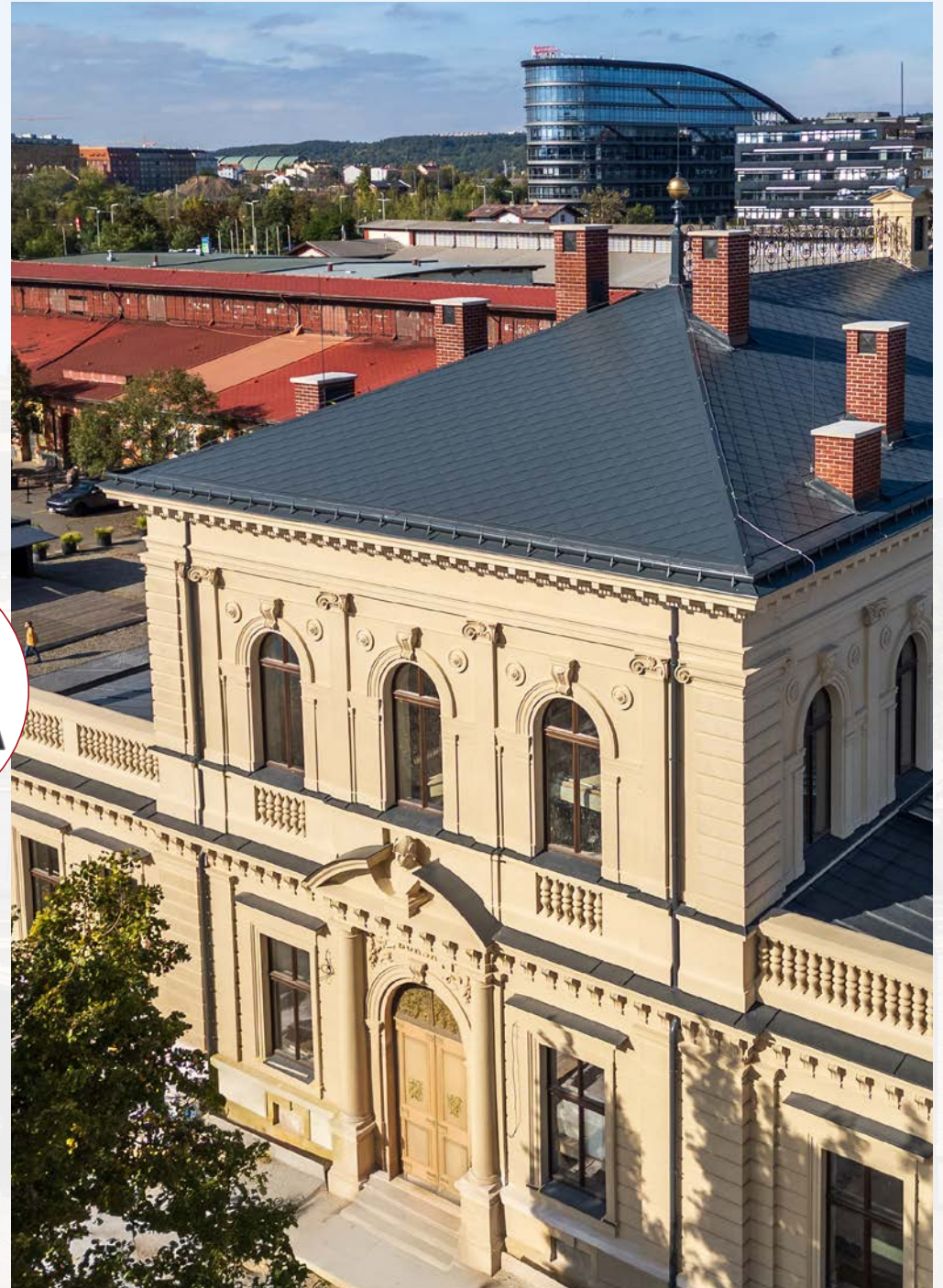
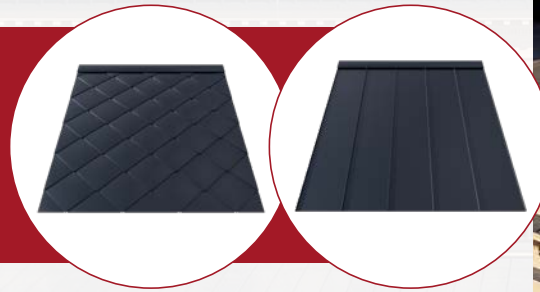


Historical reconstruction

Holešovice | Prague

Complete reconstruction of the **historic slaughterhouse building from 1895** in the Prague – Holešovice Market. The reconstruction included the removal of non-original additions from 1928, which disrupted the symmetry of the building, typical of representative buildings from this period. The Prague Rudolfinum, for example, was built in a similar style. **The decorative facade, original stucco, and unique interior** were professionally restored. The roof is adorned with COMAX ComBo and COMAX Falc roofing, which perfectly met the expectations of preservationists.

Čistá | Liberec Region

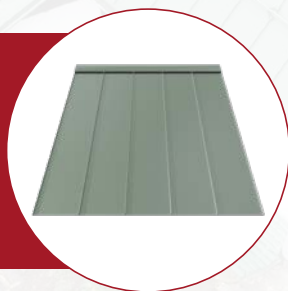

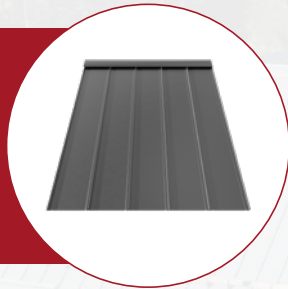


Farmhouse near Lipno

Complete renovation of a former farmyard, which is adorned with COMAX Klik steel covering **more than 1,000 m² of roofing**, including a gutter system in the same colour as the roofing, snow guards, ventilation strips, and other necessary accessories for the proper and long-term functionality of the roof cladding. This project is proof that even **historic buildings can be given a new life** with the use of top-quality materials and precision craftsmanship.

Jílové u Prahy | Central Bohemian Region

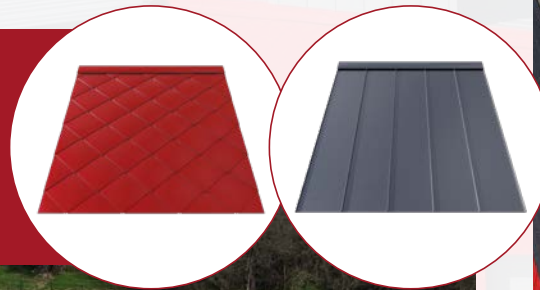

Děčín | Ústí nad Labem Region

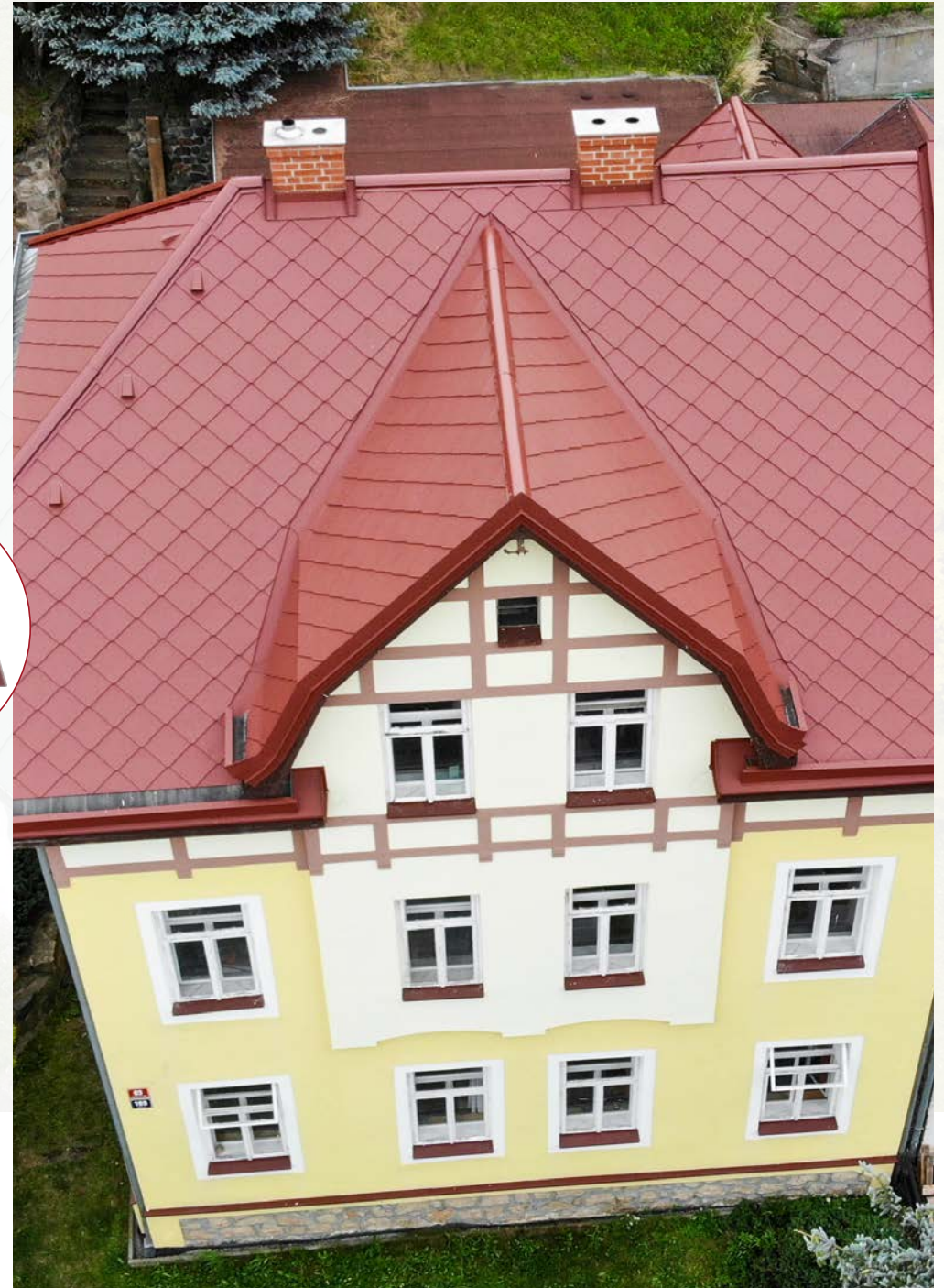

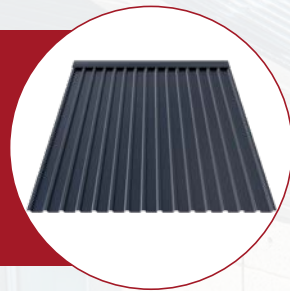


From flat to pitched

Líšnice | Central Bohemian Region

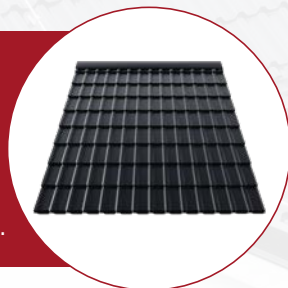

Bedřichov | Liberec Region

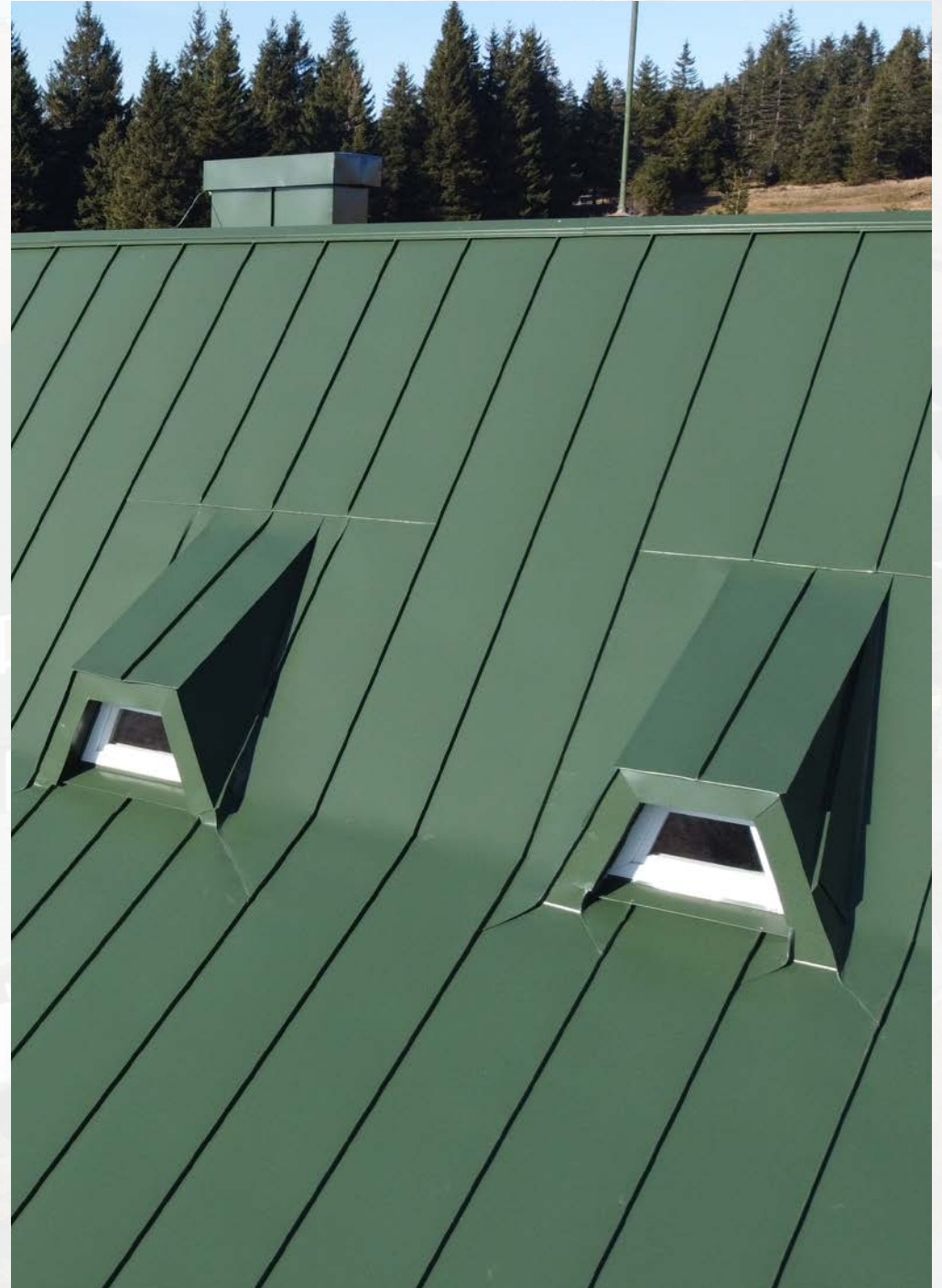
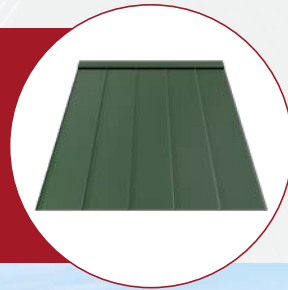
The Malý Šišák Hotel, standing at an altitude of 1155 meters, was built in 1911. In 1936, it was struck by a major fire, but it was successfully restored and reopened for recreational purposes. The gradual renovation of this legendary hotel, located in the beautiful landscape of the **Krkonoše National Park** is being carried out with respect for history and nature. In the first phase of the reconstruction, more than 400 m² of surface area is being covered with COMAX Falc in **green colour 6020, typical for mountain areas**.

Rumburk | Ústí nad Labem Region

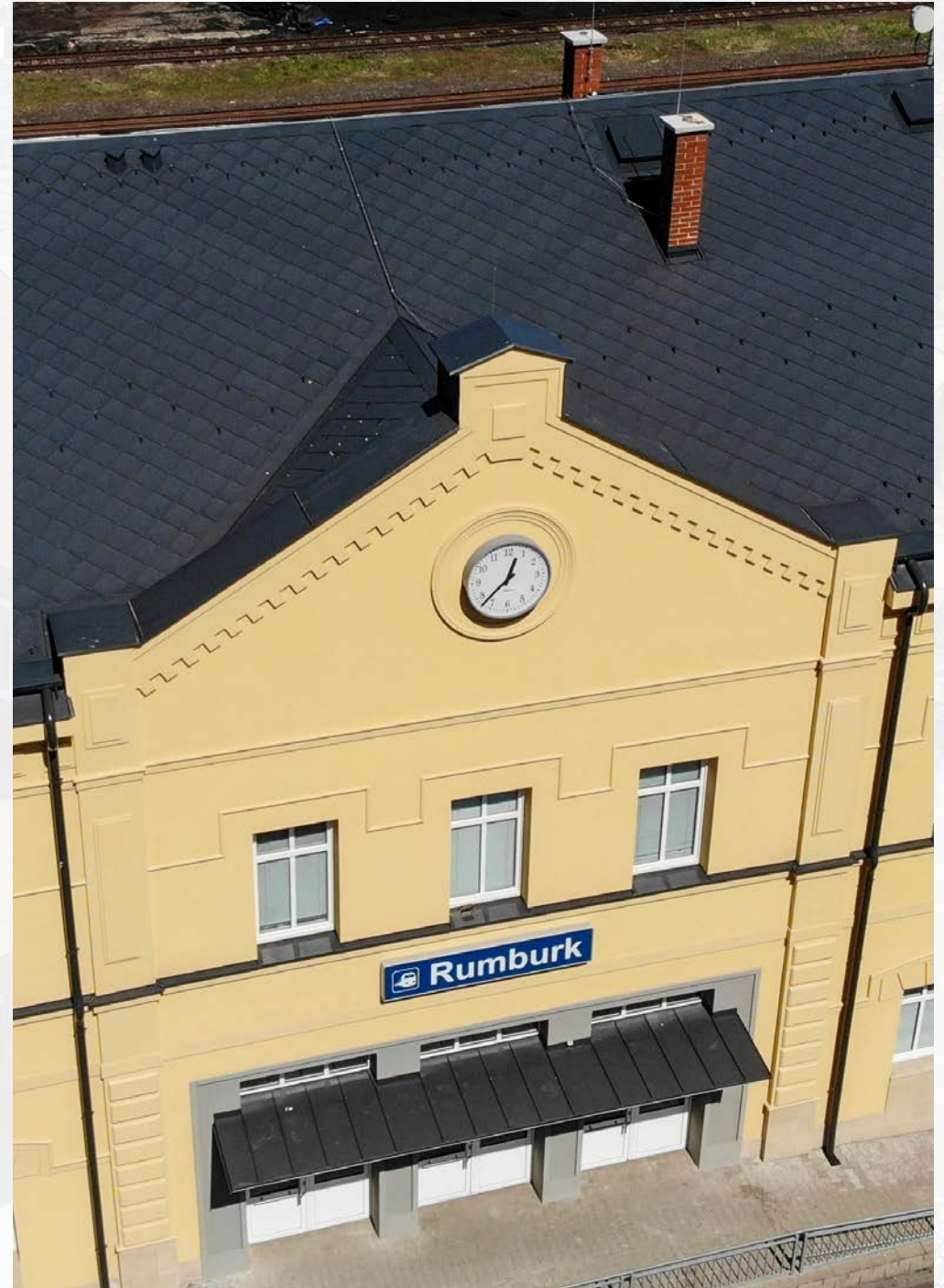
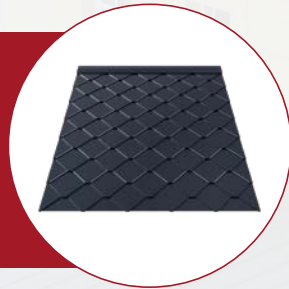

Boží Dar | Karlovy Vary Region

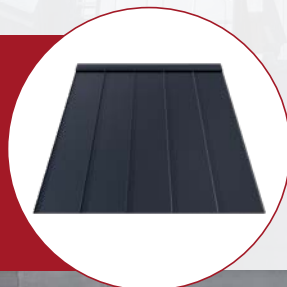

Bližší Lhota | South Bohemian Region

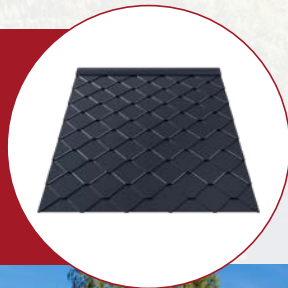
